

**Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization,
597 U.S. 215 (2022)**

is a landmark decision of the United States Supreme Court in which the court held that the United States Constitution does not confer a right to abortion. The court's decision overruled both *Roe v. Wade* (1973) and *Planned Parenthood v. Casey* (1992), devolving to state governments the authority to regulate any aspect of abortion that federal law does not preempt, as "**direct control of medical practice in the states is beyond the power of the federal government**" and the federal government has no general police power over health, education, and welfare.
