The MSK Committee strives to:

- Assist in the planning of the Annual Meeting Roundtable Program and Regional Meetings Roundtable Program, and the review of submitted abstracts related to orthopedics and musculoskeletal diseases
- Review the status of the MSK field and compile position papers on the relevant scientific issues that must be addressed to advance or enable cellular therapies for musculoskeletal diseases
- Offer educational opportunities to Early Stage Professionals (ESP) in the MSK field

Projects, responsibilities, and opportunities for the ESP member

The ESP will participate as a full voting member of the Committee and engage and collaborate in project tasks and assignments with other members and teams. In particular, the ESP member will be asked to help the Committee conceive, review, and refine program opportunities to increase the value of ISCT to ESP members, and to increase the engagement of ESPs in ISCT as their preferred science and networking community.
