Location:

Transportation :

Baltimore-Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport (BWI) is about 12 miles from the Lord Baltimore Hotel. Estimated drive time is 30 minutes from BWI Airport and 75 minutes from Washington DC (IAD). The hotel is located three blocks from the Inner Harbor, National Aquarium, and the Baltimore Arena.
