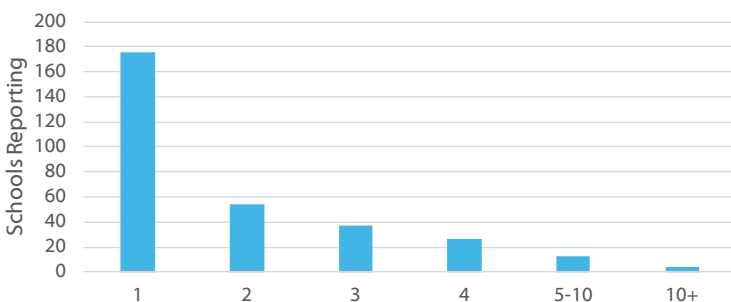

30% report PeopleSoft.

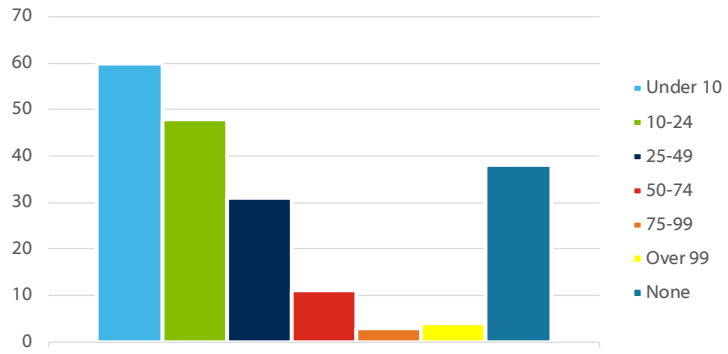
314 respondents are from the United States. **22** are from Canada. Other countries represented: Australia, New Zealand, Singapore, and Qatar.



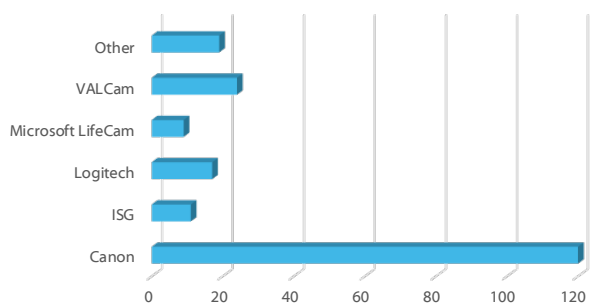
