**NACCU Welcomes David Anthony as Board President**

**Phoenix, AZ – April 23, 2019** – David Anthony was welcomed as NACCU President at the NACCU 26th Annual Conference on April 9, 2019. He was elected as NACCU President-Elect at the Annual Meeting of the membership in Reno in 2018. In accordance with Bylaws, he began serving as President at the 2019 Annual Meeting. He will serve as President through the 2020 Annual Conference.

David Anthony has been Director of BuckID at The Ohio State University since 2006. David earned a BA at Gonzaga University in 1999 and an MBA at Ohio State in 2005. As the Director of BuckID, David is responsible for oversight of transaction system operations, integrations, support, and partnerships.



David has been an active member of the campus card community over the past eleven years and is a frequent presenter at industry conferences. He has served on the NACCU board as Secretary, Assistant Treasurer, Treasurer, and President-Elect. Prior to joining the NACCU Board of Directors, David served on the Corporate Relations and Membership Committees. He has managed the NACCU mentor program and has served as a mentor several times.

The Ohio State University is located in Columbus, Ohio. With a total enrollment of over 64,000 students and approximately 30,000 faculty and staff, it is one of the largest universities in the United States. Since it was founded in 1994, the scope of BuckID has grown each year. BuckID controls door readers, laundry readers, copy/print readers, vending readers, and over 300 off-campus merchants in a self-managed merchant program. Additionally, a 10-year partnership with the local transit system has authorized millions of rides, and BuckID processes over \$30 million in annual financial transactions.

BuckID issues over 60,000 cards per year, and includes both a card office in Columbus as well as card offices at five regional campuses throughout Ohio.
