NREMT & NAEMSE are partnering to bring a one day intensive workshop to skill lab instructors, exam proctors, and those interested in evaluation of team leader and team member competencies. Course coordinators and program directors are also welcome, but the objective of this free workshop is to help those involved in scenarios throughout their educational program and those responsible for evaluating readiness for entry-level field competency through scenarios.

These **Scenario Evaluation Workshops** will be held in various locations across the U.S. beginning in February 2017 and run throughout the entire year.

Participants (limited to a total of 40-50) will be guided through the scenario evaluation process by NREMT staff and Workshop Instructors who have already experienced the Phase I Psychomotor Exam which includes the Integrated Out-of-Hospital Scenario. Activities such as scenario construction, calibration, and evaluation are part of the workshop presentation. All of the scenarios created will be available for your use following the event.
