Dear Chair Aderholt, Ranking Member DeLauro, Chair Capito, and Ranking Member Baldwin,:

On July 23, 2025, your offices received a letter signed jointly by 17 members of the National Alliance for Family Engagement. In that letter we urged you to protect important budget items that support meaningful family, school, and community engagement from proposed eliminations, cuts, and deemphasis via consolidations into block grants as seen in the President's FY26 budget request.

In the time since, the Senate Committee on Appropriations approved the FY26 Labor, Health and Human Services, Education, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act by a bipartisan vote of 26-3. Comparison details are below. We want to thank the Senate Committee for strongly supporting programs that benefit families, schools, and communities by largely maintaining the funds we identified in our July 23rd letter.

We, the undersigned 208 organizations, write in recognition of these new developments. We urge the House to, like the Senate, prioritize family engagement programs by maintaining funding for these programs and reaffirming their commitment to the children, families, and communities they serve.

First, the Administration's proposed FY26 budget sought to consolidate and cut through the "K-12 Simplified Funding Plan." We applaud the Senate Committee on Appropriations for maintaining specified funding streams and also sustaining funding at FY24 levels. The tables below show FY24 amounts, the Administration's FY26 proposed funding, and the amount approved by the Senate Committee on Appropriations.

Second, unlike the Administration's proposal to eliminate several programs entirely, the approved Senate Committee on Appropriations bill largely sustains these commitments. The lone exceptions are a \$15m cut to Full-Service Community Schools and a \$2.5m cut to Ready to Learn Programming. We hope that the House version of this appropriations package at least maintains prior program funding.

Finally, we want to applaud the Senate Committee for keeping certain sections of IDEA as individual programs rather than roll them into a block grant as requested in the Administration's FY26 proposal. Moving these programs into a block grant would pit these important initiatives against one another and create significant state-to-state inconsistencies in services. We hope the House version similarly sustains line-item funding for these programs.

We ask that the House, like the Senate, maintain these programs and sustain individual funding streams rather than block grants. We also ask the House to restore the limited cuts found in the Senate Committee's package. We applaud the Senate Committee for advancing an appropriations package that avoids pitfalls found in the Administration's proposed FY26 budget that would devastate children and families.

Although this letter, like the July 23rd letter, focuses on the need for investments in the FY 2026 Department of Education budget, we also hope Congress remembers education is reinforced by

investments in various other health and human services that must similarly be protected, such as Head Start, Medicaid, SNAP benefits, and mental health services.

Supporting families is a non-partisan issue that has historically enjoyed bipartisan support. The Senate Committee's 26-3 vote on the LHHS bill demonstrates this as well. We sincerely hope you protect these programs and their positive impacts on the country's children, parents, families, and communities.
