Charter

Purpose

The purpose of the Block Grant Committee is to ensure effective implementation of the federal block grant program and to support current and future block grant states.

Objectives

Promulgate best practices and work to advance the NASAO mission.
Coordinate with FAA to ensure policies and guidance are consistent across the states.
Collaborate with FAA to identify existing and needed areas of mutual interest and concern.
Strongly encourage and mentor additional states considering participation in the program.
Determine issues to convey to the Legislative committee for consideration and action.
Identify and submit recommendations to the NASAO Center regarding training and research.
Solicit speakers and topics related to the block grant program for the annual conference.
Provide input to the NASAO Executive Committee as needed.

These objectives may have associated annual goals as determined by the committee.

Membership

Shall include a member from each active block grant state.
May include additional state members with an interest in the block grant program.
States must be in “good standing” in order to participate.

FAA and stakeholders will be invited to participate on issue specific task groups.
NASAO staff will support the activities of the Committee as necessary.

Leadership

The Chairperson will serve for one (1) year at the pleasure of the NASAO Executive Committee.
A new chairperson will be selected upon recommendation to the Executive Committee by a majority of the committee members at the annual meeting.

Meeting Schedule

The Committee will meet monthly to include a quarterly conference call with FAA staff.
Additional/Special meetings may be called by the Chairperson.

Charter Review

The charter will be reviewed annually at the September meeting.
