Ethics & Morals

Ethics

- 1. moral principles that govern a person's behavior or the conducting of an activity.
- 2. branch of knowledge that deals with moral principles.

Morals

- 1. a lesson, especially one concerning what is right or prudent, that can be derived from a story, a piece of information, or an experience.
- 2. a person's standard of behavior or beliefs concerning what is and is not acceptable for them to do.

- Driving = Morals'






Societal Impact

- Morality Is Not Fixed. Apply To Specific Group At A Specific Point In Time



Critical Thinking

- Merriam Webster Definition: the act or practice of thinking <u>critically</u> (as by applying reason and questioning assumptions) in order to solve problems, evaluate information, discern biases, etc.
- Ethical Implication Definition: ability to gather, process, validate, question, and conceptualize; facts from fiction, rule vs. best practice, validity vs. availability, and truth from opinion with thoughts supported by the rationality of statistics and a "why" vs. "what" mentality.







- Listen to Language







Critical Thinking Outcomes
