

Angela Carter, ND (they/them)

Dr. Angela Carter (they/them) is a queer, trans, genderqueer, neuroqueer, disabled, naturopathic primary care physician, midwife, sexual assault examiner, trans health advocate, harm reductionist, and health justice activist.

Angela is proud to have survived as Program Manager for the initial rollout year of Oregon's Measure 110 statewide Substance use Decriminalization, Treatment and Recovery Program with the Oregon Health Authority. Angela currently serves as Chair of the Oregon Psilocybin Advisory Board, drawing from a peer model of support and from volunteering for 10 years as a medic and station lead with Burning Man Emergency Services, as medical lead with the Queerdome psychedelic



support and harm reduction community, and as a Peer supervisor for Fireside Project's psychedelic support and harm reduction line. Angela is certified in MDMA assisted psychotherapy through MAPS. They serve as an advisor for Alma Training Institute for Psilocybin Facilitation.

Prior to their work at the state, Angela created a culturally specific, health at every size, trauma informed consent based, sex and SW positive, harm reduction focused primary care and midwifery practice serving the queer and transgender communities of Oregon. The practice grew rapidly and it became apparent that a full spectrum, integrative, low income community clinic was deeply needed in Oregon. In response to this need, Angela and Katie Cox co-founded the Marie Equi Institute, a nonprofit queer and transgender health advocacy organization, where Angela directed the primary care and medical education programs from 2015-19. Angela volunteers with many queer and transgender advocacy organizations. They are a founder and chair emeritus for the OHSU Transgender Health Program Community Advisory Board. Angela has had the privilege of providing care to over 1000 trans and non-binary community members over their last decade in practice.

Angela teaches transgender, non-binary, and intersex health care, psychedelic medicine, and trauma informed, justice oriented health care practices at medical schools and conferences nationally and internationally.

Angela is an unassuming, relatively introverted, deeply nerdy, dirt-worshiping witch. They cherish the quiet and powerful strength and wisdom of trees and mycelial networks, making botanical medicine, crocheting sculptural hats, and the company of cats.
