HOW TO APPLY

All applications must be submitted online at www.nconewater.org/StudentApplication

All required forms, listed below, must be uploaded through the online system no later than March 15, 2023, for application to be considered.

RECOMMENDATION LETTERS

Two letters from college instructors, including at least one letter must be from an engineering instructor. Signed letters must be submitted online by instructors at www.nconewater.org/ScholarshipRecLetter

ESSAY

Discuss your reasons for choosing a career in engineering with a focus on the water environment and what contributions you hope to make that will improve the water environment. (Maximum 800 words)

TRANSCRIPT

Official transcript with college/university seal

AWARD

One \$1,000 scholarship plus free attendance to the 2023 NC One Water Annual Conference

EDUCATION LEVEL

Undergraduate student

INSTITUTION

University of North Carolina system college or university with an ABET accredited engineering curriculum

PROGRAM/COURSE OF STUDY

Engineering with a concentration in the water environment

CUMULATIVE GPA

Greater than 2.75 (on a 4.0 scale)

CITIZENSHIP AND RESIDENCY

Must be a U.S. citizen and a resident of North Carolina

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Preference will be given to members of an NC One Water/NC AWWA-WEA student chapter.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Candidates for scholarships will be required to show interest in the manufacturer's representative role in the water industry by:

- Participating in an outreach program which requires them to visit with an NC manufacturer's representative firm of their choice for one eight-hour day, and
- Demonstrate an active interest in environmental sales and marketing by taking electives in that area, and
- Applying for an internship with a manufacturer's representative firm during the summer of their junior or senior year.

RENEWAL ELIGIBILITY

The scholarship may be renewed annually through the recipient's senior year by providing documentation that the recipient still meets the qualifications stipulated in the initial scholarship application.

PAYABLE TO

Paid directly to financial office of recipient's educational institution

CONFLICT OF INTEREST

The applicant must not be related to scholarship sponsors nor employed by such sponsors and not an employee of nor related to officer or director of NC One Water, nor to any member of the Endowment Committee.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

Please do not submit any additional materials with your application. Materials that are not requested will not be reviewed nor will they be returned to you.
