Discuss why you want to be a water professional and what contributions you hope to make to improve the quality of the water environment. (Maximum 800 words)

## AWARD

One \$3,000 scholarship plus free attendance to the 2023 NC One Water Annual Conference

## EDUCATION LEVEL

Undergraduate

## INSTITUTION

College or university in North Carolina

## PROGRAM/COURSE OF STUDY

Curriculum that emphasizes the protection of public health by providing healthful drinking water and/or protecting the quality and integrity of the water environment

## CUMULATIVE GPA

Greater than 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale)

## CITIZENSHIP AND RESIDENCY

U.S. citizen

## MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Preference will be given to members of an NC One Water/NC AWWA-WEA student chapter.

## RENEWAL ELIGIBILITY

The scholarship may be renewed annually not to exceed four years for completion of an undergraduate degree and two years for completion of a graduate degree by providing documentation that the recipient still meets the qualifications stipulated in the initial scholarship application.

## PAYABLE TO

Paid directly to financial office of recipient's educational institution

## CONFLICT OF INTEREST

The applicant must not be related to scholarship sponsors nor employed by such sponsors and not an employee of nor related to officer or director of NC One Water, nor to any member of the Endowment Committee.

## ADDITIONAL NOTES

Please do not submit any additional materials with your application. Materials that are not requested will not be reviewed nor will they be returned to you.
