General

The online sponsor and exhibitor application, properly executed by sponsor or exhibitor, shall constitute a valid and binding contract. The New England Healthcare Engineers' Society (herein referred to as NEHES), reserves the exclusive and total right to control all aspects of the conduct of this event; and specifically, it reserves the right to determine the eligibility of any sponsor for inclusion in the Conference Sponsorship. Requests for sponsorship may be refused or restricted due to space limitation or other reasons determined by NEHES. NEHES also reserves the right to render all interpretations and decisions, should questions arise, and to establish further regulations as may be deemed necessary to the general success and well-being of the Sponsorships and Conference. Conference management's decisions and interpretations shall be accepted as final in all cases. NEHES will have sole control over all admissions of persons to the Conference. The acceptance of this contract does not carry nor imply endorsement of the product or service by NEHES.

Sponsor agrees to conform to all rules and regulations stated below. Breaches or infractions of these rules may jeopardize the right to sponsor at future conferences hosted by NEHES.

Payment for Sponsorship

Payment to secure a sponsorship or exhibit space must be received within 30 days of invoice; otherwise, the sponsorship may be forfeited to a company on the waiting list. The post-conference attendee list will only be shared once full payment has been received.

Cancellation/Refund

All sponsor and exhibitor sales are final. Exchanges may be allowed on a case-by-case basis, at the sole discretion of NEHES.

Assignment of Space

Sponsorships are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis, based on the date the contract is received by NEHES, date of full payment received by NEHES and the availability of requested sponsorships. NEHES reserves the right to assign sponsorships based on other equitable considerations, to alter the exhibit floor plan, to change location assignments or relocate the exhibit area at any time, as it may deem necessary. NEHES also reserves the right to reassign sponsorship selections, as it may deem necessary and equitable.

Competing Event Policy

It is the policy of NEHES to prohibit sponsors, exhibitors, exhibiting companies and other participants from holding meetings, separate social functions or events to ensure these activities do not compete with or detract from the NEHES Spring Seminar.
