Yet I had no one to talk to at length who thought of the evidence in a similar way. It was an incredibly lonely feeling and a significant challenge to my faith that lasted for over two years.

That was until I finally heard about and attended a local ASA event. It was there that I engaged with members who were like-minded on these science and faith issues and were filled with great perspectives. In addition, attending ASA's annual meeting last summer

in Nashville with my son (a 19 year old pre-med student at Grove City College) was one of the highlights of my life. We thoroughly enjoyed fascinating workshops and seminars as well as the opportunity to dine and converse with senior scientists and well-known authors. Both of these opportunities with the ASA were life changing to me.
