

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

What is NPIAP?

The National Pressure Injury Advisory Panel (NPIAP) is an independent not-for-profit professional organization dedicated to the prevention and management of pressure injuries. NPIAP is a Panel made up of:

- Board of Directors: Consists of voting Directors, one non-voting member from each of the Councils, and a liaison from the Guideline Governance Group (GGG), and may or may not include an Immediate Past President.
- Councils: Collaborating Organization Council (COC), Corporate Advisory Council (CAC), Patient Advisory Council (PAC), Provider Organization Council (POC), and Alumni Council (AC)

How do I join NPIAP?

NPIAP is a Panel made up of the Board of Directors and NPIAP Councils. The Board of Directors consists of 15 voting directors, the Immediate Past President, and one non-voting member from each of the four councils. NPIAP has five councils, which are listed and described further below. The panel meets together two times per year to discuss the needs and progress of NPIAP and the community related to the prevention and management of pressure injuries.

Our councils consist of the following:

- Alumni Council: Former Board members who have continued an active role in the NPIAP mission.
- Collaborating Organization Council (COC): Non-profit or governmental professional organizations that share the NPIAP mission and collaborate to achieve it.
- Corporate Advisory Council (CAC): A diverse group of corporations that supports the NPIAP mission by providing both financial support and human resources.
- Patient Advisory Council (PAC): The Patient Advisory Council panel is made up of individuals and organizations who have firsthand experience with pressure injuries.
- Provider Organization Council (POC): Profit or non-profit organizations whose main objective is patient care.
