

# Northwest Chapter of the American Association of Airport Executives 2019 Application Availability Announcement Airport Certified Employee (ACE) Scholarships

The Northwest Chapter AAAE (NWAAAE) supports members who choose to pursue becoming an Airport Certified Employee (ACE) in the areas of Airfield Operation, Airfield Lighting Maintenance, Security, Communications, Airport Trusted Agent, and Safety Management Systems through the American Association of Airport Executives (AAAE).

To further this objective, NWAAAE has established the Airport Certified Employee (ACE) scholarship program with the intent of supporting Chapter members who desire to attain Airport Certified Employee (ACE) certification through AAAE. Both the online self-study and in person review course provided by AAAE are eligible for scholarship funding.

The scholarship is open to all categories of Chapter members based on the following criteria:

1. Applicant must have been a member of the Northwest Chapter for at least one year prior to the date of application.
2. Applicant must be employed at an airport within the Northwest Chapter region or a company providing services to an airport(s) within the Northwest Chapter region.

Applications and all supporting documents for 2019 ACE Scholarships must be received by February 28<sup>th</sup> with scholarships anticipated to be awarded by March 15<sup>th</sup>. Scholarship recipients will have until December 1<sup>st</sup> of 2019 to achieve their ACE designation at which time the Chapter will reimburse them for the **registration costs** of the ACE program upon submittal of receipts. The scholarship award is intended to reimburse expenses net of any other employer support or scholarship received for same costs.
