



COVID-19 UPDATES – April 23, 2020

Permit Renewal Update

All permits issued by the Department of Buildings and expiring from the beginning of the declaration of the state of emergency through the period of the emergency declaration are extended in accordance with the [Mayoral Emergency Executive Order NO.17](#). Currently this period runs through March 12, 2020 through at least May 09, 2020.

Permit Renewal Extension

Permits already in effect remain in effect until the end of the term for which they were issued. Permits that will expire during the state of emergency have been extended for the duration of the state of emergency. If the state of emergency is extended the permit expiration will be automatically extended.

There are no changes to the permit renewal process.

While the expiration date has been extended, you must maintain adequate insurance coverage

The DOB is in the process of transitioning to a system of online license renewals. More details will be provided next week.

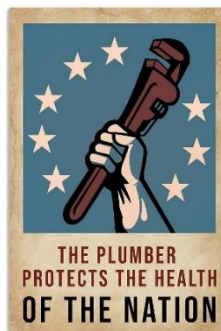
