Notice to All NYSLTA Members

The Nassau County Clerk initiated a land records computer system change-over in October 2015. The process was complex and mostly completed by December 2015.

Professional examiners and recorders reported interface issues as they came across them. The technology vendor continued to make refinements in the body of data accessed by the new system. Extended features, such as listing judgements, continued to be made into January of 2016.

As of this date, NYSLTA is advised by the Office of the Nassau County Clerk's Office that the data available for examination in the Nassau County online system is accurate and complete.

The computerized records and reports of the records may be considered reliable ranging back to 1992. Searches for dates prior to 1992, are best conducted on site at the County Records Office in Mineola.
