Training or experience required: Get your FAA UAM License. Fly a DRONE in a logging operation - operations are modernizing and dropping Hay-lines via drones.

Job duties could include: Support natural resource management activities, including forest health protection, wildfire suppression, research, recreational impacts, and law enforcement. Drones are also used to fly and drop a hay line for ease of setting up cable operations. Water lines and hoses for fire fighting can be dispatched by drone. Additionally emergency assistance equipment can be quickly sent into the field.

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Physical Fitness: How physically demanding is this job? **2/5**

This is not a very physically demanding job. Standing and monitoring Drone location.

Work Outdoors: Is this a job that is in the cab of a machine – or are you outside and exposed to the elements? **3/5** *This is a job where you need to get in and out working vehicles and on a job site.*

Technology: How technical is this job? **4/5** *Drones are quite technical and always advancing in technology.*

Previous Experience: Is this job entry level or is it a more advanced job, or is training needed? **3/5** *Previous equipment operating experience is recommended, as well as understanding harvest operations.*

Leadership: Is this job a lead position or not? **2/5** *Very infrequent leadership requirements.*

Work Independently: Is this mostly working alone or with others? **3/5** *This sometimes an independent position, but does involve communication with people on the landing.*
