Whether you're a seasoned presenter or presenting for the first time, we welcome proposals from all backgrounds and perspectives.

All abstracts are reviewed by PFA Educational Committee. Accepted abstracts may be combined with related ones to form panels. PFA membership is not a pre-requisite for submissions.

Incomplete proposals and/or proposals that do not follow the guidelines will be declined. One individual or group of presenters (limit to two presenters per group) may submit a maximum of *three* different presentations.

Notification of Results

Webinar Sessions abstracts are reviewed and notified as soon as possible.



Presentations

PFA will copy and make presentations available to session attendees. Presenters are required to provide an electronic copy (limited to a maximum of 10 pages) of their handout materials no later than January 15th, 2027.

Submission Checklist (form below)

- 1) Completed Submission Form for each presentation, returned electronically to **abstracts@pedorthics.org**.
- 2) Three learning objectives that will be met through the course of your presentation.
- 3) Detailed presentation abstract that explains in 75–100 words what the attendees will learn or “take away” from your presentation.
- 4) 50-75-word biography or summary about each presenter that explains qualifications for presenting this program.
