What does the commitment involve? Members of the NAPPS Board of Directors are the stewards of the association and are responsible for reflecting the views and interests of all NAPPS member/owners. In addition the board provides leadership, supports the vision and mission of the association and shares the responsibility to oversee the fiscal health of the association.

- Up to two in person board meetings per year.
- Three telephone conference calls per year, approximately two hours in length.
- Governance Committee participation is a requirement (1st year only).
- Newly elected Directors at large shall serve initially for a term of one year and upon recorded affirmative vote by a majority of the Board serve two additional years to be counted as one three year term.

1. Please provide biographical background information, including an overview of your pet sitting business.
2. Please list relevant accomplishments or service.
3. Please tell us what contributions you feel you could make.
4. Please tell us why you wish to serve.
