Business Materials and Forms – Veterinary Treatment Authorization

A veterinary treatment authorization (electronic or hand-written) covering pets in the care of a pet sitter is a very important document. This document, when it is signed by the customer, gives permission for veterinary treatment of the sick or injured pet. The following components should be included:

- Company name.
- Client name.
- Pet(s) name(s).
- Date.
- Statement that the pet sitting service is authorized to transport (or engage on-site veterinary services) and present pet(s) for veterinary treatment.
- Statement that client will be responsible for treatment fees.
- Spending limit.
- Client signature or electronic signature
