WHO

Student must be sponsored & employed by a PHCC member to participate in program.

WHAT

Classroom Instruction – 160 Hours/Year (September – April)
On the Job Training (OJT) while employed with a PHCC contractor member

WHEN

Twice /Weekday/ Evening Classes
Program Classes Follow Normal College Calendar Year with Holidays/Summer Vacation

COST/YEAR

Tuition & Textbooks (Sponsoring Employer will make arrangements with their employee) \$1,000 (approximate)

Once employed by a member plumbing company, the student provides documentation required for the program along with a current apprenticeship license registration with the Texas State Board of Plumbing Examiners, a high school diploma or GED, SS# and/or Resident Alien Card, and verification of Selective Services Registration. Student provides own required hand tools and transportation to/from class.

BENEFITS TO A DOL APPROVED PROGRAM

Completion of the course reduces the Texas State Board Plumbing Examiners (TSBPE) required OJT hours for an Apprentice applying for the Journeyman exam from 8000 hours to 7500 hours. Completion of the program reduces the TSBPE required time for a Journeyman applying for the Master Plumbing exam from 4 years (8,000 OJT hours) to 1 year (2,000 OJT hours). In addition, upon completion of the 4 year apprenticeship program, all TSBPE required OSHA hours, CODE hours and Continuing ED hours are satisfied for taking the Journeyman exam with the TSBPE.
