



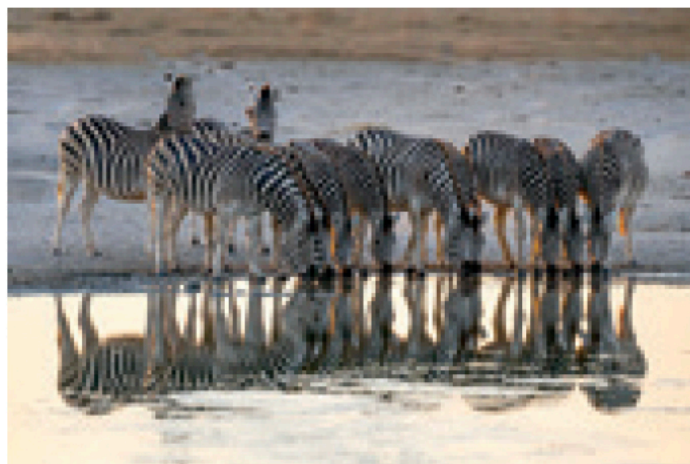

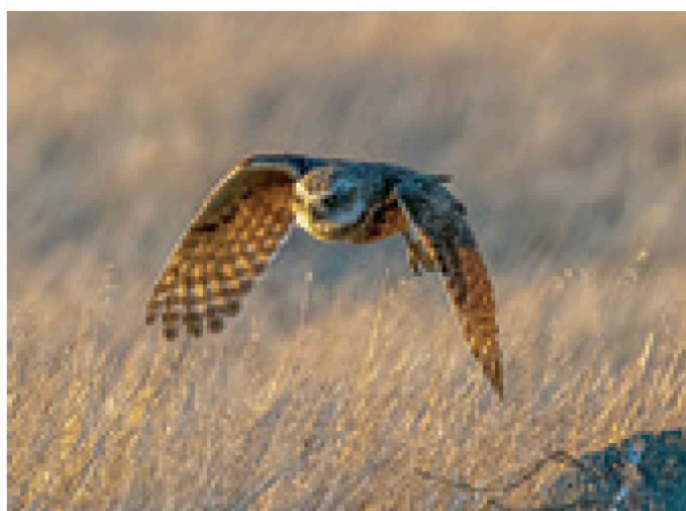

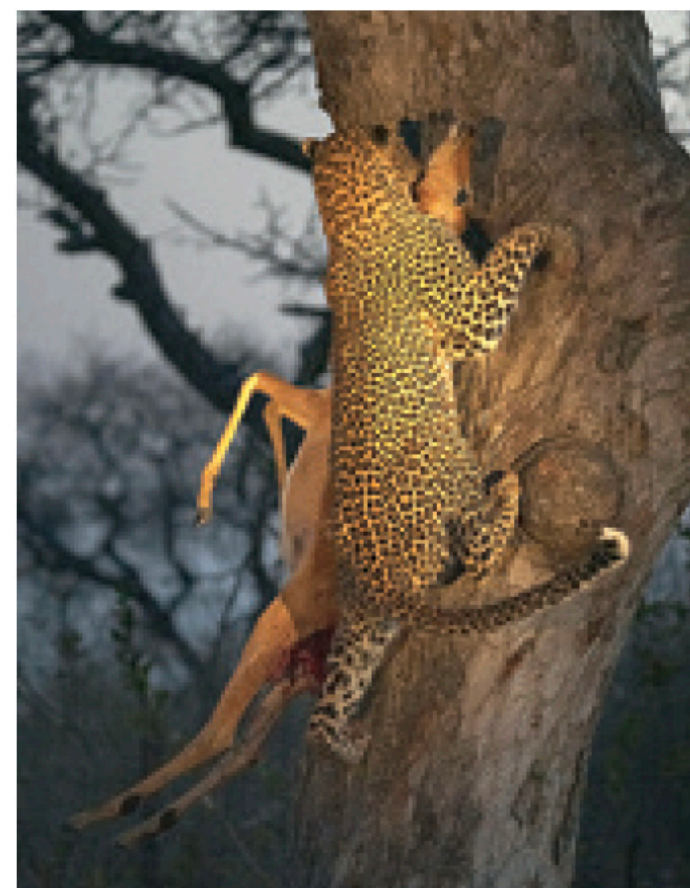

“Wildlife Only” Results

There were 539 entrants (authors), from 57 countries, who submitted 3,724 images to be judged.
