


Application Denials










| Denial Key | Explanation |
|------------------------------------|--|
| Acknowledgment Needed | Applicant failed and/or declined to complete the mandatory Acknowledgement forms required for further processing of the application. |
| Adverse Actions | Any adverse actions taken against any psychology license ever held by the Applicant. |
| E.Passport/IPC Revocation | This occurs when ASPPB has issued an E.Passport and/or IPC prerequisite certificate but the certificate is revoked prior to the APIT and/or TAP application being reviewed/approved by PSYPACT |
| Not Licensed in "Home State" | Applicant declared a PSYPACT state as "Home State" but does not hold a full, unrestricted license to practice psychology in that jurisdiction. |
| Permanently Expired E.Passport/IPC | Applicant's prerequisite certificate (E.Passport and/or IPC) was issued more than two years prior to the date their APIT and/or TAP application was completed. |

Authorization Revocations







| Revocation Key | Explanation |
|---------------------------|--|
| Adverse Actions | Any adverse actions taken against any psychology license ever held by the PSYPACT Authorization Holder. |
| E.Passport/IPC Revocation | This occurs when ASPPB has issued an E.Passport and/or IPC prerequisite certificate but the certificate is revoked prior to the APIT and/or TAP application being reviewed and/or approved by PSYPACT. |
| Renewal Denied | Upon review of a renewal application, it was determined that the Authorization Holder no longer satisfies the eligibility requirements to maintain an APIT and/or TAP authorization. |
