REQUIREMENTS: To be done on lead line. Trot may be done rising or sitting. No voice allowed by rider or assistant. Rider must be under the age of 12. Assistant must wear protective footwear.

PURPOSE: This is an introduction to dressage for the beginner child rider.

A – Enter at walk; X – Halt, Salute; proceed at walk				
C – Turn Right				
M – B – Trot rising or sitting, walking a few strides before B				
B – Turn Right, E – Turn Left				
E – K – Trot rising or sitting				
K – Walk				
A – Down Centerline; X – Halt, Salute				

Leave arena in walk at A.
