PVDA Rider Achievement Awards Program

The PVDA Rider Achievement Awards Program, initiated in 2005, recognizes **riders** (not horse/rider combinations) for percentile scores earned at PVDA schooling shows and USEF licensed / USDF recognized shows. Since this is a rider award, scores earned by the rider on different horses may be submitted. Riders are awarded a certificate and an attractive lapel pin, as depicted above.

There are 6 separate awards for scores earned at Introductory Level thru Fourth Level at PVDA-sponsored schooling shows. And, 6 separate awards for scores earned at licensed/recognized shows. The schooling show scores must be earned at PVDA sponsored schooling shows (not chapter shows or other schooling shows). The licensed/recognized scores may come from any open USEF Licensed / USDF Recognized Dressage Show (not breed-restricted shows).

For each award, **four** qualifying scores are required, as follows:

Level	Qualifying Score
Introductory Level	65% or higher
Training Level	63% or higher
First Level	62% or higher
Second thru Fourth Level	60% or higher

The scores must have been earned under at least three different judges and from at least two different shows. All schooling show scores must be from at least an “L” judge in order to qualify.

You can take as long as you like to earn the scores, ride different horses, and can earn awards at as many levels as you like, as long as you are a PVDA member at the time the scores were earned.

This award program was begun on January 1, 2005. All scores must be earned subsequent to that date. Scores from several different competitive years may be used, as long as the rider was a paid PVDA member in good standing at the time the score was earned. If a rider joins PVDA midway through the year, any scores earned previous to his or her membership date (or during a lapsed period of membership) will NOT be considered qualifying scores.

The Rider Achievement award may be earned once per level per rider for schooling shows, and once per level per rider for licensed/recognized shows.

The rider/member is solely responsible for reporting qualifying scores to the PVDA Rider Achievement Awards Program Chairperson. Scores are reported by sending a Rider Achievement Award Score Report Form, a copy of each qualifying test, and a copy of PVDA Membership Card(s) for each year in which the qualifying scores were earned.
