- Any late applications **cannot** be considered.
- Any incomplete application forms will **not** be considered.
- Supportive documentation needs to be attached in pdf format.
- Please scan and send all documents together in one attachment.

Selection criteria:

- The bursary is available to students who have successfully **completed** their 2nd and/or 3rd year of study in the degree for Speech-Language Pathology or Audiology
- The main criteria for selection of the application are financial need and academic performance.
- Changing your degree after submitting your application will lead to the cancellation of the bursary and the student will need to repay any funds to SASLHA immediately.

Instructions for submission:

(Please complete the online application form and enclose the following documentation in pdf

- Copy of your certified ID document
- Copies of academic records / grades for all completed years
- **Testimonial from a clinical supervisor or relevant professional on letterhead. Refer to specific information required.**
- **Copies of applicant's most recent three months personal bank statements**
- **Signed affidavit to confirm that all documentation are original or copies of original documents.**
- **Submit a video recording (maximum 2 minutes)** briefly answering the following questions: Tell us something about yourself, why you believe you deserve this award and how you plan on contributing to the profession in the short and medium term. The video can be taken with your cellphone or laptop, should be compressed to less than 10MB and added as an attachment to the email with your application form.

 - Clinical skills (fair-good-excellent)
 - Interaction with clients, colleagues, staff (fair-good-excellent)
 - Punctuality, preparation and administrative skills (fair-good-excellent)
- Provide at least one example of a positive engagement that you witnessed or experienced with regards to this student.
- Why would you recommend this student for the Myrtle Aron Bursary?
