

SCCT Poster Guidelines

Presentation requirements

Posters need to be up by 9:30am on Tuesday, Jan. 30, 2018 and must come down by 3:35pm, Wednesday, Jan. 31, 2018. Posters still remaining as of Thursday, February 1 2018 am will be disposed of.

Posters will be displayed on standard cloth-covered poster boards. Pins or Velcro tabs will be provided.

Two posters will be displayed on each board — one on each side. Numbers will be attached to the boards. Match your corresponding assigned number seen on the poster session assignment document to the number on the board to find your assigned spot.

Poster session assignments and listings are indicated in a separate document.

There will be one dedicated poster session. It will take place on **Tuesday, Jan. 30, 2018 at 3:10 – 4:00pm**. During the Moderated Poster session, the presenting authors must be available at their poster to present the work. Moderators are assigned to each session. They will visit all posters and engage poster authors in a question-and-answer dialogue.

Size and structure requirements

The maximum poster size is A0 size (841 mm wide x 1189 mm tall). Anything over A1 size (594 mm x 841 mm) must be displayed as portrait. **Please pay strict attention to this size limit, as larger poster sizes cannot be accommodated.**

For optimal readability, posters should:

- Utilize contrasting colors, such as blue on white, or white on dark green.
- Have a clear, simple typeface.
- Use bold or medium character thickness.
- Should have a font larger than 30 pt. This ensures readability at 6 feet.
- Acronyms or abbreviations must be defined.

Suggested Poster Headings:

- Purpose — The stated purpose should be concise; usually in no more than 3 sentences.
- Hypothesis/Objectives, Methods, Results — This should be the primary focus of the poster and should contain the bulk of your information.
- Conclusions — A concise conclusion based on the evidence presented in the Results section should be provided.
