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| <b>Do I need to be an SCMR member to apply?</b>                           | Yes, only SCMR members are eligible to receive the designation of FSCMR.   |
| <b>How do I apply?</b>  | Visit <a href="http://SCMR.org">SCMR.org</a> and complete the online application for FSCMR.  |
| <b>What is considered a “complete application”?</b>                       | Applications are considered “complete” if they include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Application fee</li><li>- Current Curriculum Vitae (CV)</li><li>- Online application</li><li>- Proof of certifications:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>&gt;SCMR Level II or III (Clinical Track)</li><li>&gt;MRI Technologist Certificate (Technologist Track)</li><li>&gt;Letter of verification from institute leader, if applicable</li></ul></li></ul> Failure to submit a “complete” application may result in delay or unapproved application. |
| <b>Can I submit documents or payment separately from the application?</b> | All documentation and fees must be submitted as a group with the completed online application. If there is a special situation where this is not possible, contact <a href="mailto:HQ@SCMR.org">HQ@SCMR.org</a> directly.<br>Failure to submit a “complete” application may result in delay or unapproved application.   |
| <b>When will I be notified?</b>   | Applicants will be notified via email at the following times: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Upon receipt of the FSCMR application</li><li>• When there is a request for additional information/ if incomplete</li><li>• When the FSCMR is approved or needs to be resubmitted</li></ul>  |
| <b>How often are FSCMR applications reviewed?</b>                         | SCMR Applications will be reviewed and approved on a quarterly basis. Application deadlines are March 1, June 1, September 1, and December 1.  |
| <b>How long will it take to receive my FSCMR?</b>                         | About ten weeks. Since applications are reviewed quarterly, it can take up to eight weeks from the application date. You will then be notified in the two weeks following.<br>Questions about your FSCMR application can be directed to <a href="mailto:HQ@SCMR.org">HQ@SCMR.org</a> .   |
| <b>What if I am not approved?</b>   | Applicants will be provided with specific reasons why they are not approved and will have the opportunity to address the issues at no additional charge. If the issues are not resolved by the next quarter’s deadline, applicants will need to reapply and pay another application fee.   |
| <b>How do I reapply if my application is not approved?</b>                | If your application is not approved and you fail to address the issues after two deadlines have passed, you will need to reapply in the same way you initially applied. (By completing the online form again, and resubmitting the documentation and application fee)  |
| <b>Do I need to renew my FSCMR?</b>                                       | No, once you are approved for FSCMR, your designation will stay active as long as your SCMR account is current.  |
| <b>What if I let my membership lapse?</b>                                 | If a SCMR member lapses in dues for 1 year or more, the member will have to purchase a multi-year membership prospectively (three consecutive years), reapply for the designation, and pay the application fee.  |
| <b>What is the application fee?</b>                                       | Clinical and Research Tracks - \$200 application fee and \$100 annual fee (included in membership dues)<br>Technologist Track - \$75 application fee and \$30 annual fee (included in membership dues)   |
