- 2. Basic knowledge, clinical training, and experience in *echocardiography*, *cardiovascular computed tomography*, *or cardiac nuclear medicine* (*whichever is/are applicable*).
- 3. Holds a valid, unrestricted medical license.
- 4. Undergone at least 3 months (cumulative) of CMR training (at least 2 months of which was full time in a CMR laboratory, and up to 1 month was independent study) under the aegis of a Level 2/3 qualified CMR mentor within two years.

- 6. Successful completion of at least 50 hours of CMR coursework.
