- NFPA 75 --Standard for the Fire Protection of Information Technology Equipment – **Rodger volunteered to work on this standard**
- NFPA 76 -- Standard for the Fire Protection of Telecommunications Facilities
- NFPPA 115 -- Standard for Laser Fire Protection
- NFPA 664 --Standard for the Prevention of Fires and Explosions in Wood Processing and Woodworking Facilities
- NFPA 805 -- Performance-Based Standard for Fire Protection for Light Water Reactor Electric Generating Plants

- NFPA 806 --Performance-Based Standard for Fire Protection for Advanced Nuclear Reactor Electric Generating Plants
- NFPA 921 -- Guide for Fire and Explosion Investigations – **Brian volunteered to work on this standard**
- NFPA 1616 -- Standard on Mass Evacuation, Sheltering, and Re-entry Programs – **Rodger volunteered to work on this standard**
