If you would like to propose a session for consideration, please submit a 250-word proposal abstract and complete the [online form](#). A proposed session may include a panel of colleagues with short presentations and a period of discussion or other individual or multiple presenter formats. Your submission should:

- Include 250-word proposal abstract
- Present a clearly identified perspective related to the SIG
- Indicate how this perspective may be useful in adult education theory and/or practice
- Identify how it contributes to our professional discourse at CPAE
- Describe the proposed presentation, content, and degree of audience participation
- List the name and contact information of all presenters (the selection will not be a blind review process).

Each SIG will take place during a 1-hour session timeframe. In most cases, there will be two presentations during the SIG session; plan your proposal with this in mind. SIG Chairs may combine ideas and proposals from presenters for the final content and format of the session.
