AND WHEREAS:

From an accounting standpoint, the year-end should be aligned with membership year-end.

AND WHEREAS:

The bylaws stipulate that membership year end necessarily be December 31st as per section 2.6;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED (required):

That the language of the bylaws be changed to state that the year-end for membership be for 12 months to be determined by the Board of directors, allowing for an improvement in the associations reporting and greater clarity for staff, board and members on the true financial status of the association.
