

Auction/Raffle Information

Raffles

Before conducting a raffle, your group must be registered with the Attorney General's Registry of Charitable Trusts. Your group also must receive written confirmation of your annual registration before holding the initial raffle. Below you will find an address to the website that gives information on how to register and report your raffle to the Attorney General of California.

Auctions

If your District is going to hold an auction you must first obtain a seller's permit from the State Board of Equalization. You can obtain and request the forms from their website at www.boe.ca.gov.

Raffling or Auctioning Alcoholic Beverages

You may not raffle or auction off alcoholic beverages unless you first obtain a liquor license. You can obtain a liquor license at your local Alcohol Beverage Control (ABC) office. Please visit their website at www.abc.ca.gov for forms and information.
