



What is the 2600 Club?

The 2600 Club is the designation used to describe and honor those individuals who have donated at least five hundred unencumbered (donations that are not in accordance with raffles, sporting events, etc.) dollars to the CAL-PT-PAC fund in a calendar year. The "2600" refers to Section 2600 of the Business and Professions Code for the State of California. This is where you will find our practice act.
