Each day of this week-long boot camp spotlights a new Colorado Principal Quality Standard, offering site administrators the opportunity to participate in just one day, several days or all five days of the series. Site administrators and those who evaluate principals will gain critical information to build their own mastery and understanding of the leadership skills principals need to know and be able to do in accordance with the new Colorado educator effectiveness evaluation rubric for principals.

This five day boot camp will provide participants with the key skills needed to:

- Develop mission-aligned, student-focused strategic goals that are rigorous and measurable, and establish effective processes to drive planning, monitoring and resource allocation. **(Standard I – Monday)**
- Establish, implement and refine expectations for curriculum, instructional practices, staff accountability, assessment and uses of data to inform professional practices. **(Standard II – Tuesday)**
- Foster a positive, inclusive school culture of high expectations and academic risk-taking that meets the diverse needs of all students. **(Standard III – Wednesday)**
- Ensure all staff is evaluated in a fair, empowering and equitable manner that focuses on improving instructional performance and developing staff leadership capacity. **(Standard IV – Thursday)**
- Establish systems for utilizing all available resources and proactively manage the complex relationships between parents, students, staff, district leadership and external stakeholders to foster engagement and ownership. **(Standards V & VI – Friday)**
