LOCAL ECONOMIC IMPACT OF TRANSIT

- Households near public transit drive an average of 4,400 fewer miles than households with no access to public transit.¹
- \$1 invested = \$4.00 in Economic Returns¹
- In Atlanta, a 2-person household using public transit and living with one vehicle save an average of \$793 per month.²
