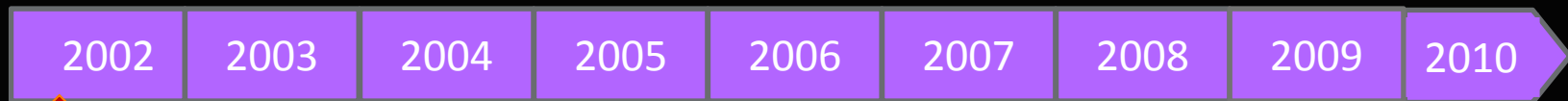

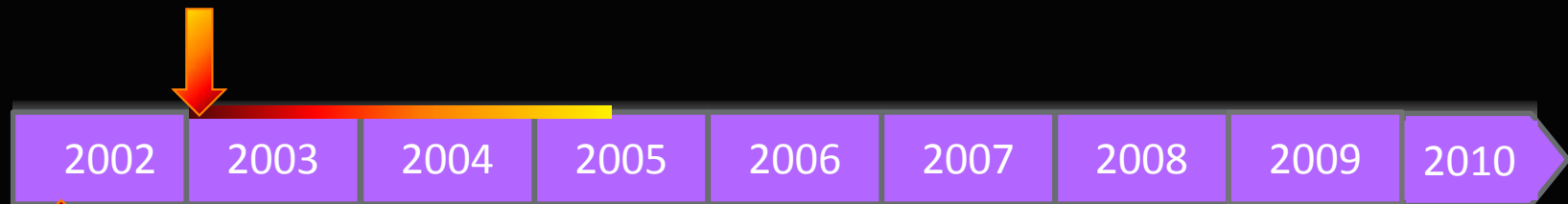

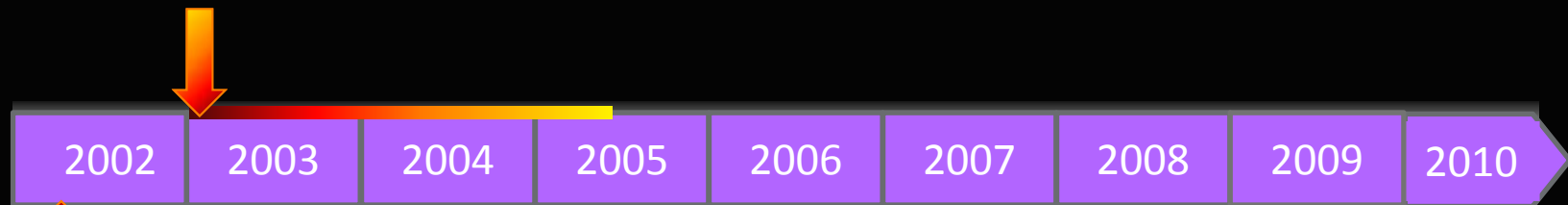

- H. Created a website.



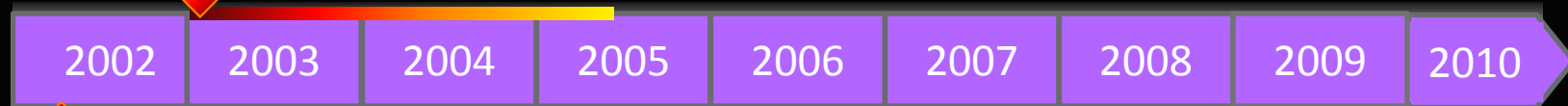

- Increase institutional capacity to prevent DV via changes in prevention policy, practice or protocol.

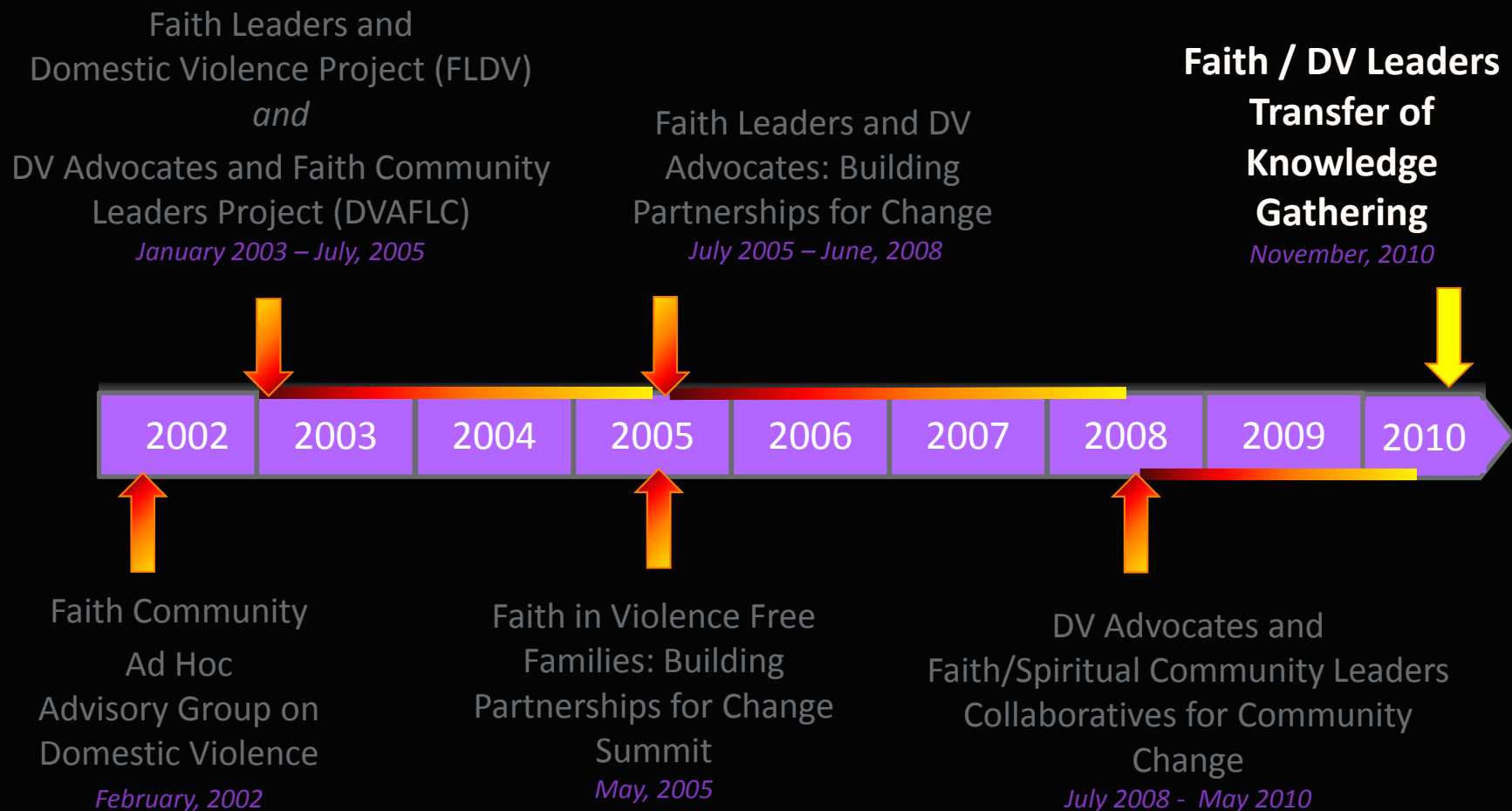
Mini Grants & TA to:

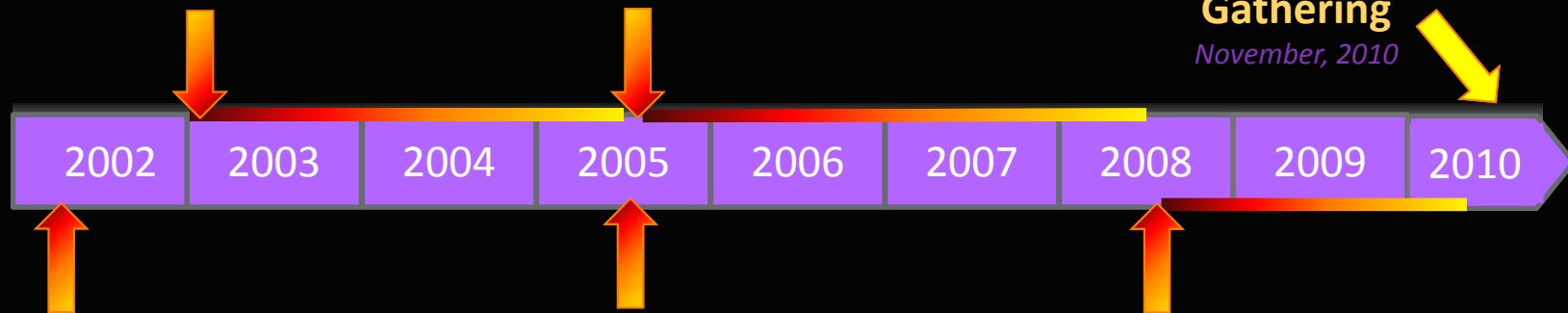
