




Median and Total (sum) State Quitline Budgets






Median Budget for Services and Medications: State Quitlines FY2005 – FY2013






Median State Quitline Spending* per Smoker FY2008-FY2013






Total & Median Calls to State Quitlines: FY2005 – FY2013






Treatment Reach of State Quitlines FY2011- FY2013
