

A Call for Candidates

SNACT's executive board is composed of both elected and appointed individuals who help make the decisions to move SNACT forward. SNACT elected officials are eligible for additional SNA leadership training and conferences. Invest in yourself and SNACT- run for office!

Members can nominate a colleague or themselves to be on the ballot.

Voting takes place on line. Voting opens in December 2025 and closes on February 1, 2026. All SNACT members in good standing will be sent a link to the voting site via email. The Board positions begin on August 1, 2026.

Open Positions:

Officers

- **Vice President:** This is a 3-year commitment that will lead to becoming SNACT President in 2028-2029. This is an executive committee position.
- **Secretary (2026-2028):** The Secretary is responsible for accurately recording minutes of meetings. This is an executive committee position.

- The IC Chairperson must be a corporate member in good standing.
