Alongside the awards will be a series of lectures, providing expert insight and case studies into the event theme – “**Net Gain**”. Confirmed speakers include Richard Deverell, Director of the Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew and Claire Wansbury CEnv, Associate Director of Ecology at Atkins.

World Environment Day celebrates and promotes environmental awareness and sustainability across the globe annually on the 5th June.
