Whereas, a traumatic injury is a blunt force or penetrating physical injury that requires surgical and other medical specialists to consult, observe or perform surgery in order to optimize recovery

Whereas, a trauma system involves the coordination of trauma care delivery among trauma centers, ambulances, helicopters, state and local governments and other healthcare resources;

Whereas, trauma centers are classified as Level I - IV dependent upon the amount of equipment, staff, and care provided;

Whereas, traumatic injury is the leading cause of death for people under age 45;

Whereas, treating severely injured patients at trauma centers reduces mortality by more than 25 percent;

Whereas, at \$72 billion annually, traumatic injuries have exceeded heart conditions and cancer as the most costly medical conditions to treat;
