<p style="text-align: center;"><u>BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CONDITIONS</u> (Tracks 1 & 2)</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Recovery focused</u> (<i>practice monitoring required</i>)</p> <p>Helping nurses recovery from substance use and/or mental health conditions.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;"><u>SOBRIETY AND MENTAL FITNESS</u> (Track 3 & 4)</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Support and monitoring focused</u> (<i>practice monitoring not required</i>)</p> <p>Helping nurses maintain and demonstrate sobriety and/or mental fitness.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;"><u>POST-TPAPN NON-ADHERENCE</u> (Track 5)</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Recovery focused (continued)</u> (<i>practice monitoring usually required</i>)</p> <p><u>Continued help for nurses whose TPAPN cases have been referred to the BON</u></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Track 1</u> Substance Use Disorder-Dual Diagnosis (SUD-DUAL)</p> <p>Two sub-tracks: a) SUD For nurses with only a substance use disorder. b) Dual (DUAL) For nurses with both a SUD and mental health condition(s).</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Track 2</u> Mental Health Monitoring (MHM)</p> <p>For nurses with either a mental health condition or a history of a mental health condition.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Track 3</u> Mental Health Support (MHS)</p> <p>For nurses who have disclosed a mental health diagnosis, are stable and do not have nursing practice violation(s) or a criminal history.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Track 4</u> Extended Evaluation (EE)</p> <p>For nurses who have had a one-time substance-related incident, and do not have nursing practice violation(s) or a criminal history.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Track 5</u> Interim Monitoring (IM)</p> <p>For nurses who have been non-adherent with TPAPN track requirements, and become disqualified from continued participation in that track. With BON approval, nurses may continue to be monitored by TPAPN while the BON investigates and makes their determination.</p>
