

### “Standing on the Shoulders of TOC to Impact an Entire Nation” Yuji Kishira, Kathy Suerken and Motoi Tobita

Yuji, Kathy and ‘Tobi’ gave a break-out session presentation to about 75 people at the “TOCICO International Conference held in Chicago in June based on their abstract:

We have been talking about the possibility to introduce TOC for Education in Ukraine. I will be very glad if we could implement it and I am ready to devote my efforts into it. I do have enough energy to persuade many people and believe it will be a success.

We will need to have an approval from our Ministry of Education of Ukraine. This is obligatory. We shall need the approbation proof. Meaning, we need the list of real schools that have adopted it. Please share reports on implementation. Unfortunately our Ministry need quantitative result comparisons, qualitative are not as welcomed. It would be also helpful to have the names and contacts of the responsible teachers for Poland, Lithuania, Latvia or Estonia in the project as they are more likely to be Russian speaking. This will help to test the applicability to our country and to allow teachers to contact each other during the first year.

Yes, you do have my permission to share my email address and our will to join the development of independent thinking on the post-Soviet area.

Dr. Ramos has been supervising the implementation of TOCfE tools at New Era HS with Dr. Heidee Ferrer (Head Teacher, English) and Mrs. Dory Teano (Master Teacher, English) as TOCfE demonstration teachers and implementers. Model TOCfE lessons in English have been prepared and being used by other English teachers. Mr. Xavior Dann Corpuz, neophyte English teacher, was appreciated in his demo-teaching integrating TOCfE tools in his lesson. Dr. Ramos requested the teachers to compile the lesson plans for future references and for sharing during trainings. She has scheduled Teachers' Training Program for the beginning school year in her new school, Qurino HS, with Dr. Rowena Cacanindin and Dr. Betty Cavo as the Division Coordinators.
