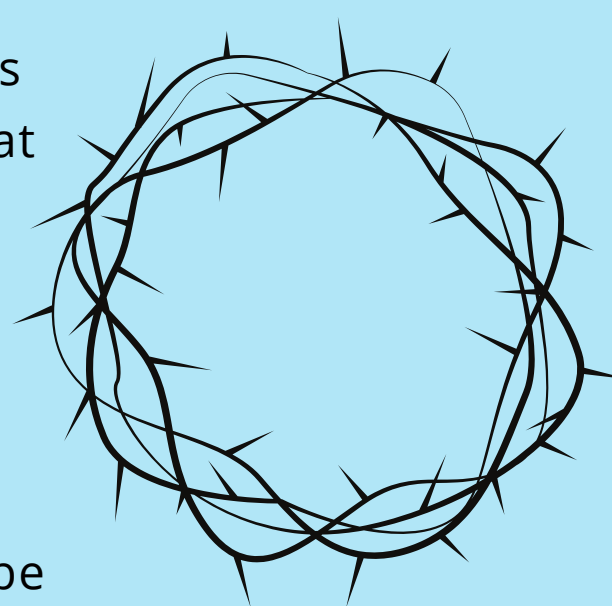


Dear Colleagues,
