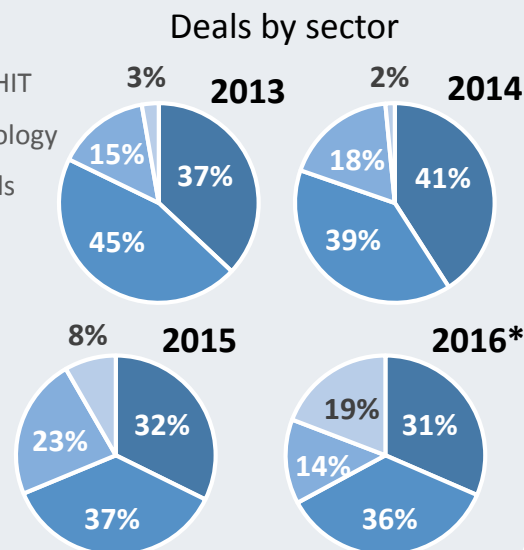
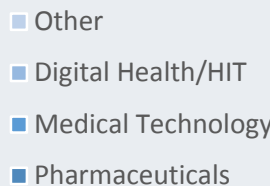
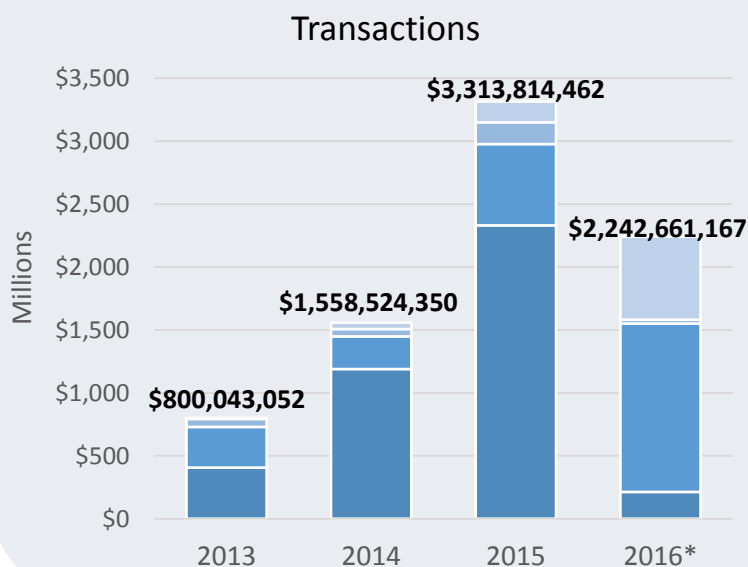

### August 2016 News Highlights:

- Benaroya Research Institute received an \$8 million grant to lead a collaborative study, with UW Medicine and Seattle Children’s Research Institute, that could lead to asthma and allergy treatments.
- Evergreen Health announced Tina Mycroft as their new CFO. Mycroft is a seasoned health care executive with more than 20 years of leadership and financial management in both the acute care hospital and large medical group settings.
- Vie Diagnostics, a University of Washington spin out, has been awarded a \$225,000 Small Business Technology Transfer grant from the National Science Foundation (NSF) to continue work on tests for infectious diseases that can return results in as little as 10 minutes.
- Biolife Solutions executes 10 year supply agreement with Bellicum Pharmaceuticals for CryoStor use in cellular immunotherapies targeting blood cancers and solid tumors.
