

WERC Duty of Care Plan

WERC is preparing the Texas Resource Convention live event experience so that all individuals onsite remain safe and comfortable throughout the event.

We are monitoring the COVID-19 pandemic and are in constant communications with the Grapevine Convention & Visitors Bureau, the Convention Center, our general service contractor, Freeman, and our internal staff.

We are facilitating measures that will ensure optimal health and sanitary conditions in all environments where in-person interaction take place.

WERC's Duty of Care

Name badges will be mailed ahead of arrival to limit onsite queuing.

The following will be provided onsite to attendees:

Masks (provided by sponsor)

- Cotton, reusable masks will be provided
- You may also bring your own mask

Hand sanitizer / Wipes (provided by sponsor)

- Personal-sized hand sanitizer will be provided by WERC and mailed to you ahead of time
- Hand sanitizer stations will be positioned throughout the meeting space

Wristbands

- Red – No contact please (6 feet apart; no exceptions)
- Yellow – Elbows only (still being cautious)
- Green – Hi-fives & handshakes (frequent hand washing)

In partnership with the Grapevine Convention Center, we will be providing

- Responsible F&B/Seating/Barriers/On-Boarding Passes for meeting spaces
- Appropriate Signage/floor decals to reinforce spatial distancing and other safety reminders
