WGCA COACHES POLL RANKINGS ANNOUNCED

CORAL SPRINGS, Florida (March 12, 2021) – The Women's Golf Coaches Association (WGCA) has announced the results of the most recent WGCA Coaches Poll. This is the second poll of the 2021 spring season.

Wake Forest University jumped to the No. 1 spot in Division I this week, receiving 10 first-place votes, while University of South Carolina remains at No. 2 with three first-place votes. Baylor University drops to No. 3 with six first-place votes, while Florida State University moves up seven spots to No. 4 with one first-place vote. Louisiana State University dropped two spots to round out the top-five.

In Division II, Dallas Baptist University unanimously remains No. 1 while University of Indianapolis holds steady at No. 2. Lynn University moves up six places to No. 3, while Limestone University trails by one point to claim the No. 4 spot. Florida Southern College jumps up nine spots to No. 5.

University of Redlands received five first-place votes to jump up five spots and claim the top ranking in Division III, while Methodist University remains No. 2 with three first-place votes. George Fox University moved up one spot to No. 3 while Carnegie Mellon University drops to No. 4 with four first-place votes. Washington University in St. Louis rounds out the top five with one first-place vote.

In NAIA, Keiser University remains No. 1 after receiving all but two first-place votes. Dalton State College and William Carey University hold steady at No. 2 and No. 3, respectively, with each receiving one first-place vote.
