WGCA COACHES POLL RANKINGS ANNOUNCED

CORAL SPRINGS, Florida (April 9, 2021) – The Women's Golf Coaches Association (WGCA) has announced the results of the most recent WGCA Coaches Poll. This is the third poll of the 2021 spring season.

University of South Carolina moves to the unanimous No. 1 spot in Division I this week, receiving all 22 first-place votes, while Duke University jumps five spots to No. 2. Wake Forest University, Louisiana State University and Florida State University all remain in the top-five, ranking No. 3, No. 4 and No. 5, respectively.

In Division II, Dallas Baptist University remains No. 1 after receiving all but one first-place vote, while Lynn University moves up to the No. 2 spot after receiving the remaining vote. Limestone University climbs to No. 3, with University of Indianapolis trailing by one point to take the No. 4 spot. University of Tampa rounds out the top-five after jumping 12 spots.

University of Redlands holds steady at the top spot in Division III after receiving nine first-place votes, followed closely by Methodist University with three first-place votes. Centre College jumps 23 places to No. 3 with one first-place vote, while Carnegie Mellon University and George Fox University remain in the top five at No. 4 and No. 5, respectively.

In NAIA, the top-three remains unchanged with Keiser University receiving four first-place votes to claim the No. 1 spot. Dalton State College comes in at No. 2 with one first-place vote, followed by William Carey University at No. 3 with two first-place votes.
